

• Pharmacy dispensing this month: 7,695



GOG-E-DEPARTMENT

General Surgery, Orthopaedic, Obs. & Gynae, ENT GH-Satpuli

GOG- E department was created in January 2023 at The General Hospital, Satpuli. Preeti Bisht is the Clinical Coordinator of the department and oversees the day-to-day operations of all the healthcare programs of **Obs. & Gynae, Orthopaedic, General Surgery and ENT departments**.

The objectives of this new development are very clear-

- 1. Planning, coordinating and carrying out patient care operations.
- 2. Respond to patient concerns timely and ensure patient satisfaction.
- 3. Coordinate with all the departments (Medical Quality, OT, Bed Management, Patient Services and Front Office etc.) on the behalf of the consultants to ensure smooth communication and speedy addressal of all the concern/focus areas.
- 4. Organizing In-house camps for general surgery, ortho, Obs & Gynae & ENT.
- 5. Counselling the patients and scheduling surgeries.
- 6. Post Discharge engagement of the patients
- 7. Focus on creating superb patient experience from admission to discharge for all the surgical patients.





Since the inception, this department is working hard to take these **four (4) specialties** to the next level of growth and efficiency. Many initiatives like installation of a permanent Laparoscopic machine, organizing regular in-house camps for each specialty, conducting educational/counselling sessions for schoolgirls, has been taken in the last 3 months. For better patient experience, a dedicated counselor has been appointed to cater the special needs of the patients under these specialties. As a result of these efforts the

General Surgery department performed over 75 Laparoscopic cholecystectomy surgeries and the Ortho dept performed 49 nos. Proximal fibular osteotomy (PFO) surgeries. In addition, many critical first-of-its-kind Orthopedic & General surgeries were performed in GH. These 4 specialties jointly improvised with a remarkable rise of 53% in the OPD numbers and 59% in the Surgeries in this quarter. There has been a noticeable growth in the performance of ENT and Obs & Gyne departments too.

CASE STUDY

GH-General Surgery

UTERINE MASS WITH COMPRESSION SYMPTOMS

52 साल की एक महिला मरीज पेट के निचले हिस्से में दर्द और सूजन की शिकायत लेकर अस्पताल आई थी। उसे पिछले 2 महीने से पेशाब और मल त्यागने में परेशानी हो रही थी और पिछले 1 महीने से योनि से खून आ रहा था।

गर्भाशय की बहुत बड़ी सूजन को देखते हुए, हमारे जनरल सर्जन, डॉ. अरुणेश दुबे ने पेट की एक सीईसीटी की सलाह दी, जिससे मरीज के पेट में ब्रॉड लिगामेंट फाइब्रॉएड/ कैंसर की गांठ की संभावना का पता चला, जिसकी पुष्टि यूएसजी में भी की गई थी। बाद में जब रोगी को भर्ती कराया गया, उसके लक्षण और बिगड़ गए और उसके गुर्दे फेल हो गए, जिसके लिए उसे चिकित्सकीय देखरेख में ICU में रखा गया। बाद में उसे उच्च जोखिम सर्जरी के लिए भर्ती कराया गया लेकिन संभवतः ट्यूमर के कारण उसके दोनों निचले अंगों में भारी सूजन हो गई थी| इसलिए मरीज को कैंसर सेंटर जाने की सलाह दी गई, लेकिन मरीज व उसके परिजनों ने जाने से मना कर दिया। क्यूंकि मरीज़ की पेशाब की दिक्कत ज्यादा बढ़ गयी और दोनों पैरों में बहुत ज्यादा सूजन आ गयी जिस कारण इस गांठ द्वारा पेशाब की थैली एवं पैरों की रक्त नली पर अत्यधिक दबाव था।

अतः मरीज़ को इन लक्षणों से आराम देने के प्रशामक देखभाल (palliative care) के उद्घेश्य से सर्जरी करने का निर्णय लिया गया और अगले दिन ही पेशेंट के गर्भाशय का ऑपरेशन किया गया। सर्जरी के दौरान काफी खून बह गया था लेकिन ओटी की पूरी टीम और हमारे सर्जन की तैयारियों से हम रक्तस्राव को रोकने में सफल रहे। चूंकि, खून की कमी बहुत अधिक थी, और रोगी को कई यूनिट रक्त की आवश्यकता थी। हमारे कर्मचारी एकजुट होकर रक्तदान करने के लिए आगे आए और जल्द ही हम रोगी के लिए 23 यूनिट रक्त एकत्र करने में सक्षम हो गए।

ऑपरेशन के बाद, मरीज को ICU में स्थानांतरित कर दिया गया था, लेकिन अगले दिन इंटरनल ब्लीडिंग के चलते मरीज को फिर से ओटी में शिफ्ट कर दिया गया और पुन: लैपरोटॉमी की गई। मरीज को आखिरकार बचा लिया गया और वह ठीक हो गया। 9 दिनों अस्पताल रहने के बाद उसे छुट्टी दे दी गई थी। भर्ती के समय मरीज का एचबी स्तर 2 था और डिस्चार्ज के समय उसका एचबी स्तर 8 हो गया था।




